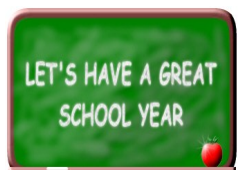

DRESS FOR SUCCESS: Just a reminder that Grassy Creek students should be dressed in appropriate school attire that promotes a positive school learning climate. Please refer to our Student Handbook, **Dress Code Guidelines, for a complete listing.** Please be sure the below listed guidelines are followed so that students will dress and groom themselves in a manner that is not disruptive to the educational process or dangerous to themselves or others.



- ◆ Students will wear acceptable tucked in shirts/tops in the school environment.
 - Shirts/tops that are unacceptable:**
 - Shirts that don't cover a student's back when bending over
 - Shirts with tears or holes
 - Sleeveless tops, see through tops, spaghetti straps, halter tops, low cut shirts or sundresses
 - Shirts with tears or holes or graphics that "put down" school
 - Leggings and/or jeggings are allowed under skirts or dresses and not just worn with a shirt.
