Warren Township was one of only 16 districts nationwide to be awarded a federal Race to the Top grant. More than \$28.5 million will support a tremendous infusion of high-tech and technology-rich learning environs in Warren Township.

PreK-4 Program and Intermediate Program

Warren offers a comprehensive curriculum and instructional program for students in pre-school through grade 4. Schools offer full-day everyday kindergarten. Art, music, and physical education are included at each school. Media Centers provide opportunities for students to explore technology through SmartBoard, iRespond, and production studios. The academic program focuses on state and national standards and student achievement. Warren Township opened three intermediate academies in the fall of 2010 to serve the students in grades 5 and 6. The intermediate academies are housed in our middle schools yet follow the elementary model. The staff provides engaging learning experiences so that students will develop the skills and knowledge needed to transition from an upper elementary setting into the middle school.



Middle School Program

Warren Township addresses the unique needs of middle school students in their 7th and 8th grade programs. The middle schools are committed to using instructional strategies and best practices that meet the learning needs and characteristics of early adolescents through core content, music, engineering technology, Spanish and other course offerings. The middle school media centers have been transformed into a technology-rich environment with collaborative learning spaces and other technology tools. Middle school students have the opportunity to build all the skills they need for high quality success in grades 9-12.

High School Program/Career Center

Warren Central High School and Walker Career Center students have the opportunity to choose from over 650 different course offerings to meet their individual needs, including a growing number of AP and dual credit, virtual and extended learning opportunities. Students are prepared for post-secondary choices which lead to J.A.M.S. (Job, Apprenticeship, Military, School). High school students earned over 3,700 college credits last year. The high school and career center offers outstanding curriculum, a caring staff, state-of-the-art facilities, and equipment, including access to the Mediaplex, which offers highly-engaging, technology rich instructional areas. The **Freshman Academy** offers students a close-knit atmosphere of a school within a school. Administrators and counselors are assigned to the Academy to assist students with the transition from middle school to high school.

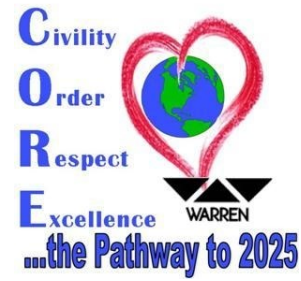


Technology

Instructional technologies and high-tech learning environments engage and motivate students. Students in grades 1-12 have 1:1 access to Chromebooks. Warren Central High School and Walker Career Center labs, 75 high-school classrooms, and all three middle school libraries (now called Mediaplexes) have been renovated to provide high-tech learning environments and to accommodate highly-collaborative work among students and teachers. Through *World Wide Warren*, eligible students may enroll in a growing number of online courses.

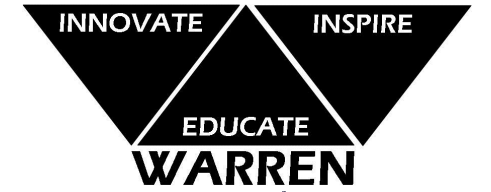

Did You Know? about Warren Township

- ◆ MSD Warren Township has a district-wide initiative—**CORE** ~Civility, Order, Respect, Excellence.
- ◆ Warren has 9 elementary schools (K-4), 3 intermediate academies (5-6), 3 middle schools (7-8), 1 high school (9-12), a career center, an alternative school, and an early childhood center.
- ◆ All schools in Warren Township follow a balanced calendar—four 9-week instructional sessions.
- ◆ Parents have 24/7 access to grades, attendance, discipline records, and lunch money through the district's Parent Portal.
- ◆ All schools are 100% wireless. Students in grades 1-12 have 1:1 access to Chromebooks.
- ◆ Full day kindergarten is offered in every elementary school in the district.
- ◆ Art, music, and physical education are part of the K-6 curriculum.
- ◆ Nine Warren schools received an A or B in the Indiana Department of Education's A-F Accountability Grading Model, including Warren Central High School.
- ◆ Dual credit opportunities are available for students attending Warren Central High School/ Walker Career Center.
- ◆ Through *World Wide Warren*, eligible students may enroll in a number of online courses .
- ◆ JROTC is offered at Warren Central High School.
- ◆ Warren Central High School has a new 21st Century learning environment known as the Warrior Mediaplex. All three middle schools have similar areas.
