The Metropolitan School District of Warren Township is committed to providing students and staff a safe environment. It seeks to prevent children and staff from being exposed to pests and pesticides. While pesticides protect children and staff from pests that may be found in the school and its surrounding grounds, under some circumstances pesticides may pose a hazard to children and staff.

Therefore, pest control practices may involve a variety of chemical and non-chemical methods that are designed to control pests effectively while minimizing potential pesticide exposure to children and staff.

To the extent that such measures involve the use of chemicals, the Superintendent or his/her designee will establish a procedure that, at a minimum, provides for:

- appropriate notices to parents, building administrators and school nurses;
- appropriate steps to identify students that are allergic to chemicals that might be used;
- maintain all required records of pest control measures employed;
- compliance with the applicable laws and regulations;
- procedures in place in the event of an emergency.
