2012—MSD Warren Township awarded \$28.5 million Race to the Top grant

- ◆ MSD Warren Township has a district-wide initiative—**CORE** ~ Civility, Order, Respect, Excellence.
- ◆ All schools in Warren Township follow a balanced calendar which includes 4 instructional sessions; a 2-week break in the fall, winter, and spring; and an 8-week summer break.
- ◆ All schools are 100% wireless.
- ◆ Warren students in grades 1-12 have 1:1 access to Chromebooks.
- ◆ Parents have 24/7 access to grades, attendance, discipline records, and lunch money through the district's Parent Portal.
- ◆ Our schools have strong PTA support.
- ◆ Warren schools have award-winning programs in sports and performing arts.
- ◆ Warren Township has full-day kindergarten for all students.
- ◆ The Warren Early Childhood Center offers preschool classes to students beginning at age 3.
- ◆ We have athletic trainers in the middle schools.
- ◆ Students attending Warren Central High School/Walker Career Center have earned over 3,700 college credits through dual college credit opportunities.
- ◆ Our Ninth Grade Academy offers a close-knit atmosphere of a school within a school.
- ◆ Walker Career Center has a partnership with the IU School of Dentistry. The dental clinic, The Jane Pauley Dental Clinic, will have Walker Career Center dental assisting students serving as chair side assistants to the dental students.
- ◆ Walker Career Center's Project Lead the Way Biomedical Sciences program is one of only 41 high schools in the nation.
- ◆ Through World Wide Warren, eligible students may enroll in a growing number of online courses to experience formal online learning and its benefits including more flexibility in their schedules and more control over the pace of their learning.
- ◆ Warren Central High School Student Council was voted top in the state.
- ◆ Warren Central/Walker Career Center's Robotics program is a model for the state of Indiana.
- ◆ ROTC is offered at Warren Central High School.
- ◆ Warren Central High School has a 21st Century learning environment known as the Warrior Mediaplex. All three middle schools have similar areas.
- ◆ Walker Career Center is home to FrontRunner Media Productions.
