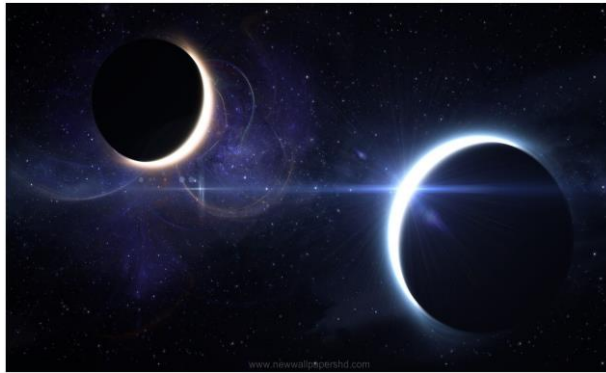

THERE IS NOT JUST ONE SOLAR ECLIPSE...

There are three different kinds of solar eclipses called: **Total, Partial and Annular Eclipse.**

A **Total Eclipse** is when the moon completely blocks out the sun while a **Partial Eclipse** is where some sun can still be seen while the moon covers only a portion of the sun. **Annular Eclipses** is when the moon blocks a portion of the sun but a “ring” like figure will be positioned the edges.

FAST FACTS...

A Total Eclipse Can Last Up to Seven Minutes Long.

When the sun, the moon, and the Earth form a line, this is known as a solar eclipse.

Temperature will drop suddenly as the sky turns black during a Total Solar Eclipse.
