Fall/Spring 2017-2018 Financial Aid Application Instructions

Your financial assistance will be awarded for the fall and spring semester which is considered to be the full academic year. If you wish to apply for loans you are limited to annual loan limits. **If you decide to enroll for the summer you will want to consider borrowing less in the fall and spring to allow for remaining funding for the summer of 2018.** Annual Loan limits are listed below.

Required Documentation

1. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2017-18 should be on file in the Office of Student Financial Aid (OSFA) **no later than July, 15, 2017**, to be considered for financial assistance for the fall 2016 semester. Martin University's federal school code is **014975**.
2. You must also submit the 2017 Fall Financial Aid Application to the OSFA. Please keep the instructions for your records.
3. If you are selected for Verification or need to submit other documents, you will receive an email or telephone notification from the OSFA indicating the information that must be submitted before your financial aid is awarded. It's important that the documentation be submitted in its entirety and in a timely fashion so as not to delay processing of your award.

Important Information

- If you drop hours or do not initiate course participation at any time during the fall or spring sessions, your aid may be adjusted and you may receive a bill.
- You must notify your financial aid counselor if you decide to cancel your fall or spring aid application.
- You must meet Martin University's standards of academic progress (SAP) in order to receive federal or state financial aid funds.
