A NOTE FROM THE NURSE.....

Sunny Heights Elementary school follows guidelines set forth by the Indiana State Health Department. Children will be sent home with a temperature over 100 degrees F and must be fever free and symptom free for 24 hours before returning to school. To protect all children from the possible spread of disease, please keep your child home if the following symptoms are present:



Diarrhea, fever (100 degree F or greater), Red or inflamed eye, undiagnosed skin rash, vomiting

Hand washing is one of the best ways to prevent illness. It is important to wash hands before and after a meal, after a meal, after playing outside, when using the restroom and whenever hands get dirty. Please encourage your child to cough and sneeze into his/her elbow or use a tissue. Together we can help keep our children healthy and in school.

Friendly reminder: If your student goes home with clothes from the clinic, please wash and return them as soon as possible. We have a limited amount of clothing to share.
