### Student Arrival and Dismissal Procedure

#### Bus Arrival

1. Bus Arrival staff will monitor student exit from bus and entry to school.
2. Student will be walked directly to their bus at dismissal. Teacher will confirm that student has boarded and been seated on the bus. Driver is aware that student should remain on bus unless administration intervenes.
3. Student sign in/sign out sheet will be completed and signed.

#### Car Riders

1. Car Riders enter through Door 1 and are directed to the cafeteria.
2. A grade level teacher escorts students to their classrooms.
3. Car Rider students gather in the lobby at 3:25pm with their numbered cards. Car Rider personnel will match student cards with those issued to parents.

#### Late Arrival

1. Any student arriving after 8:40am must have a parent sign student in at the front office.
2. Students will be escorted to their classrooms.

#### Early Dismissal

1. Parents wanting to pick students up before dismissal, must sign students out at the front office. Parents picking up student will be verified using Emergency Contact information.
2. Administration will be alerted if anyone not on the emergency contact list comes to pick student up. Identification will be required.
3. Parents will sign and date the Sign In/Sign Out sheet.

### GUEST TEACHERS WANTED!!

Warren Township schools are looking for classroom guest teachers for the 2016-17 school year. Classroom guest teachers also referred to as substitute teachers, work a 7 1/2 hour day with a 30 minute lunch. Classroom guest teachers are paid \$72 a day and are eligible for a \$100 bonus after completing twenty classroom assignments. With 18 schools, and over 600 classrooms in the district, there are ample opportunities for being assigned to a classroom on a daily basis. ## HOME & CONNECTION

### Snack Attack

"I'm starving!" When your child bursts through the door after school or daycare, she's probably hungry. Try these tips for healthy snacks that will give her the energy she needs to play and do homework.

### Stock the Kitchen

Whatever is in the house is what your youngster will eat – so shop with that in mind. Get interesting fruits and vegetables in different colors. Buy mango or peach salsa, and let your child dip in veggie sticks (carrot, celery, jicama). Stock popcorn to air pop (rather than getting less healthy microwave popcorn). Then, offer her choices. She'll have a say in what she eats, but she'll be choosing only from healthy foods.

### Have a mini-meal

Breakfast or lunch foods can make a good snack. You could serve oatmeal with raisins and nuts or tuck scrambled eggs into a pita pocket. Or try individual pizzas on whole-wheat English muffins. Top each half with a little tomato sauce, shredded low-fat mozzarella cheese, and vegetables (sliced mushrooms, chopped onions), and bake until the cheese melts.



### Build your own

Let your child get creative in the kitchen, and she'll be likely to eat the results. She can make kebabs by threading fruit (grapes, melon chunks) and low-fat cheese cubes onto toothpicks. Put out cookie cutters for her to cut sandwiches into fun shapes. Or she could spread peanut or almond butter on rice cakes, apples, or bananas and decorate them with raisins and nuts.

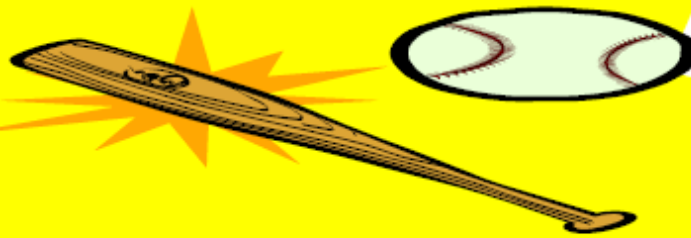
