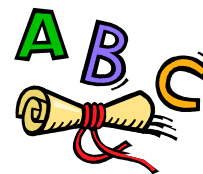
THE LAST DAY OF SCHOOL WILL BE

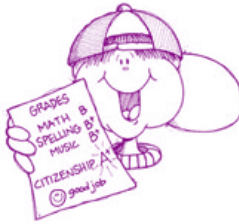
