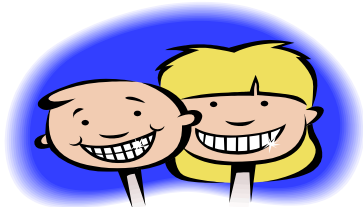

Attendance: A Key To Your Student's Success

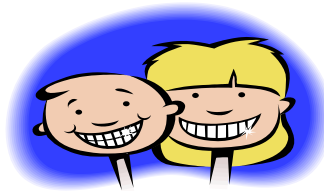
Learning builds day by day. A child who misses a day of school misses a day of learning. Research show that children who are in school every day do better on state tests. Children can copy notes or make up assignments, but they can never get back what's most important: the discussions, the questions, the explanations by the teacher and the thinking that makes learning come alive! A student who is 10 minutes late every day will miss 30 hours of instruction during the year.

Reminders:
