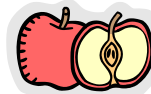

Parents, community members, and staff are invited to attend. The forum will provide an opportunity for attendees to share their insights on educational legislation or other concerns.



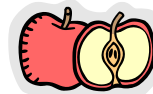
Warren Township Youth Tennis
