Early Childhood Education (one-year program)

The Early Childhood program prepares students for employment in early childhood education programs. Students entering the classroom should enjoy working with preschool children. The students must recognize the value and worth of each individual child. Early Childhood student assistants supervise children while engaged in a wide variety of creative activities such as storytelling, music and poems with actions, role-playing, art and learning centers. Students will serve as cadet teachers at the Warren Early Childhood Center.
