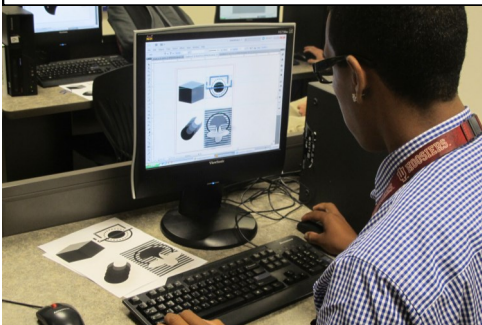

Graphic Design and Layout

Like working with your hands to “bring an idea alive?” Interested students will take Computer Illustrations and Graphic Design and Layout classes. In Computer Illustrations students will design and create flyers, newsletters, handouts, letterhead brochures and other business-related documents. In the Graphic Design and Layout classes students will incorporate a variety of visual art techniques to design and execute layouts and illustrations for advertising, displays, promotional materials, and instructional manuals. Instruction also covers advertising theory and preparation of copy, lettering, posters, and artwork in addition to incorporation of photographic images. The class also offers you the chance to design and screen your own T-shirt and make personalized memo pads allowing you to step through some of those behind-the-scenes processes that go into making the printed product.
