BMV OUT-OF-STATE TITLE “RULE OF 3” REINSTATED

In a conference call today the BMV informed ADAI the new BMV policy outlined in item #4 of ADAI Regulatory Bulletin #25 regarding out-of-state title attachments had been overturned. ADAI and BMV had received numerous calls and messages regarding this controversial policy change and were attempting to rectify the situation amicably.

Upon review of Indiana statutes, regulations and policy, the BMV concurs with Indiana Annotated Code (regulation) which allows an Indiana dealer to attach up to three (3) reassignments on an out-of-state title. (140 IAC 6-1-14) Therefore, **effective immediately, you do NOT have to obtain an Indiana title for a vehicle with an Ohio title prior to reselling the vehicle in Indiana.** – The old ‘rule of 3’ still applies.
