BMV & Department of Administration Issue RFP 3-29 - PROCESSING SPEED TITLE APPLICATIONS

The Indiana Department of Administration (IDOA), acting on behalf of the Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) and pursuant to IC 9-16-1-4(a)(2), requires a partial service license branch for the specific purpose of processing speed title applications. On September 24, 2002, IDOA entered a Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 3-29 with the intent to solicit responses to the RFP in accordance with the proposal preparation section and specifications contained in the RFP.

The purpose of RFP 3-29 is to invite proposals to provide and operate a partial service license branch that meets the requirements and approval of the Bureau of Motor Vehicles. The purpose of the partial service branch is specifically to process speed title applications for Indiana automobile dealers. Currently, the BMV has a pilot project with a contractor for processing speed titles as a partial service license branch in order to accommodate the increased volume of titling requests for untitled motor vehicles imported from Canada. The purpose of this RFP, in addition to what is mentioned above, is to provide more convenient speed titling services for Indiana automobile dealers and accommodate the speed title applications for dealer imported motor vehicles. A pre-proposal conference will be held on Wednesday, October 9, 2002 from 10:00 a.m. EST to 12 noon EST in the IDOA Procurement Bid Room W468, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, IN. All questions regarding this RFP must be submitted in writing to the address indicated in section 1.6 of the RFP no later than 3:00 p.m. EST on October 16, 2002. The IDOA Procurement Division at the address indicated in the RFP section 1.6 **must receive all proposals no later than 3p.m. EST on October 30, 2002.**
