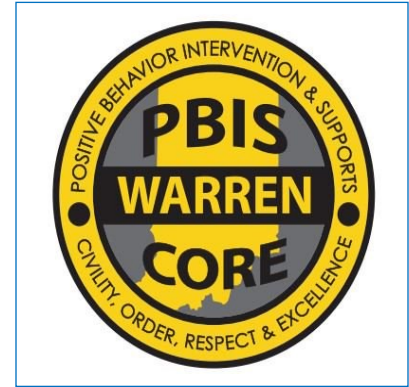
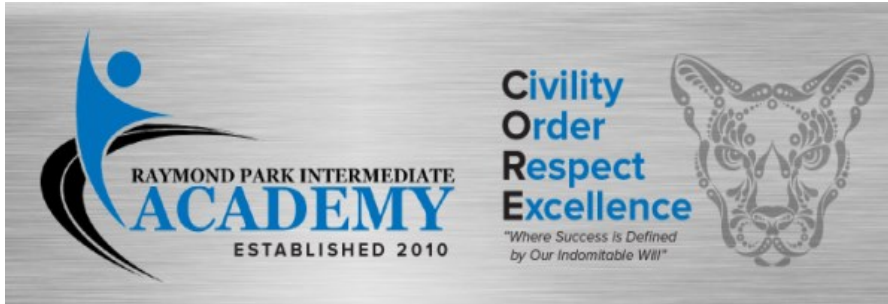

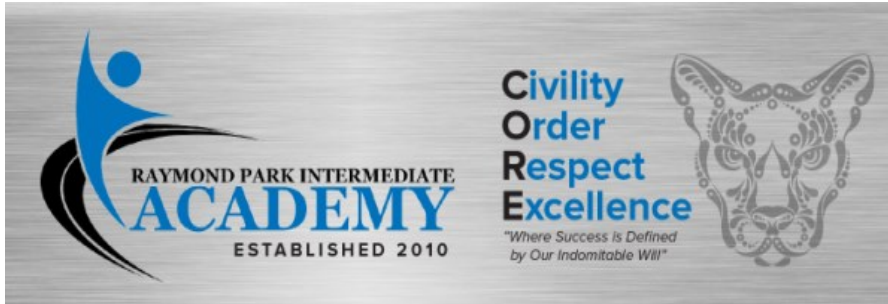
## Volunteers

If you would like to volunteer in any Warren Township school, you need to complete a Criminal History Background Check form and provide a copy of your driver's license or state I.D. You will need to allow approximately 2 weeks for the Background Check to be processed.

## Phone Numbers

Please be sure to notify the school of any changes in home, cell or emergency phone numbers. This is very important in case of an emergency or illness. Please let Mary know at 532-8965.

The occasion may arise when the school district wants to recognize your child or your child's school. This may include your child's photo, your child's name or your child's work in district publications, newsletters, on school district websites, and in electronic/social media or in staff training videos. We may also want to tell the media (including newspapers, television, and radio) about your child's achievements. We never knowingly release information about a student to anyone who wants to use it for commercial/political purposes. However, we will honor your request to not include your child in these types of recognitions if you notify your child's school office in writing that you do not want this type of information released.



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## CORE Bus Expectations

Please discuss with your student the importance of CORE Bus Expectations which will be reinforced throughout the school year. Students are to be seated, facing forward, and stay in assigned seats while the bus is in motion. These expectations focus on keeping students safe as they travel to and from school every day. ## Guest Teachers

Warren Township schools are looking for classroom guest teachers for the 2016-17 school year. Classroom guest teachers, also referred to as substitute teachers, work a 7 1/2 hour day with a 30 minute lunch. Classroom guest teachers are paid \$72 a day and are eligible for a \$100 bonus after completing twenty classroom assignments. With 18 schools, and over 600 classrooms in the district, there are ample opportunities for being assigned to a classroom on a daily basis. # REGISTRATION INFORMATION

2017-18

First Day of School: Monday July 31<sup>st</sup>

**ALL new and returning K-8 students are REQUIRED to register at the school they will be attending.**

### What to bring with you to registration:

#### Students NEW to Warren Schools:

- \*Textbook rental payment (cash, check, or charge)
- \*Immunization records
- \*Birth certificate (with official seal)
- \* Parent/Guardian Photo ID
- \*Records from former school (e.g. report card, high school transcript, withdrawal verification)
- \*Custody documents if applicable
- \*2 proofs of residency one from category A and one from Category B or C.
- A: Current Gas or Electric Bill
- B. If You Own: Closing documents, Warranty Deed, Current Monthly Mortgage Payment Statement, Quit Claim Deed, Current Year Tax Bill, Homestead Property Claim, Lease to Buy Contract, or Purchase Agreement. Driver's license or mortgage coupon books are NOT acceptable proofs of residency.
- C: If you rent: Current Valid Lease

#### Students RETURNING to Warren Schools:

- \*Textbook rental payment (cash, check, or charge) (WCHS students will receive textbook rental information in the mail in September)
- \*Additional immunization records
- \*If you have moved, 2 proofs of residency one from Category A and one from Category B or C:**
- A: Current Gas or Electric Bill
- B. If You Own: Closing documents, Warranty Deed, Current Monthly Mortgage Payment Statement, Quit Claim Deed, Current Year Tax Bill, Homestead Property Claim, Lease to Buy Contract, or Purchase Agreement. Driver's license or mortgage coupon books are NOT acceptable proofs of residency.
- C: If you rent: Current Valid Lease

At the time of registration, **K-8** students will receive: Classroom assignments or schedules, supply lists, & lunch application forms.
