All medications in the clinic must be picked up by a parent or guardian by the end of the school day on June 1st at 1:30 pm. Any medication not picked up will be destroyed.

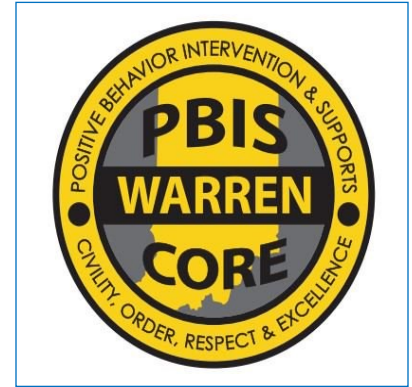
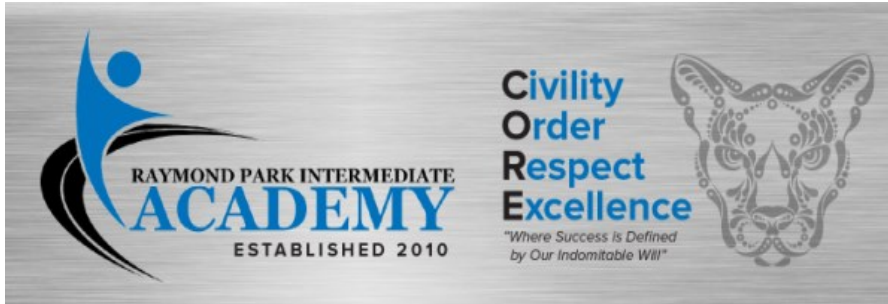
