

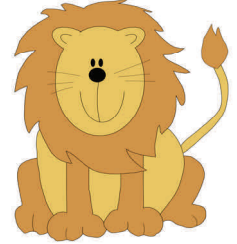

School Hours

8:30 Buses/Cars Unload 8:40 School Begins
3:40 School Ends 3:45 Buses Depart

Students will not be released from vehicles or school buses before the 8:30 a.m. start time. Students must remain in their vehicle until a Lakeside staff member signals their release. **When a student arrives late, an adult needs to escort the child to the office (no drop offs)** and complete a late pass before going to class.

Parents, please call by 9:00 am each day to report an absence. Please leave the name and room number of your child, your name and the reason for the absence. Please send a note/doctor's note back to school with your child.

Physical Education Dress

Students need to wear athletic shoes and clothing comfortable for exercise on all physical education days. Lakeside uses a 4 day rotation for Unified Arts. Students will have PE on Red, White, Blue or Green day. Please learn and plan for your child's PE day.



The occasion may arise when the school district wants to recognize your child or your child's school. This might include your child's photo, your child's name, or your child's work in some of the district publications, newsletters, school district website, or in staff training videos. We may also want to tell the media (including newspapers, television and radio) about your child's achievements. We never knowingly release information about a student to anyone who wants to use it for commercial/political purposes. However, we will honor your request to not include your child in these types of recognitions if you notify your child's school office in writing that you do not want this type of information released.



School Dress Wear Policy

Lakeside School has a Standardized Dress Wear Policy. Please check your child(ren) each morning for proper school dress. Students arriving at school out of uniform will call home for acceptable clothing. See our Lakeside handbook for additional information regarding this policy.

Student Drop-off/Pick-up Procedures



We ask that our parents follow these guidelines to insure that every student has a safe arrival and dismissal:

In order to increase the safety of all of our students and adults entering and leaving the building each day, all students will be required to be dropped-off and picked-up through the car rider line. Parking at the front and East end of the building and walking children to and from the entrances will not be allowed. We would like to prevent children and adults walking through the path of cars or buses on the property at any time.

Staff members will be present outside beginning at 8:30 a.m. each morning for student drop-off. Please do not release your children until a staff member signals the beginning of our process. Students will not be counted tardy until 8:40 a.m. Our afternoon pick-up procedures will begin at 3:30 p.m. If you are in a hurry, you are encouraged to be at or near the front of the line and we will implement our dismissal procedures as quickly and safely as possible for all.

Thank you very much for your support with helping ensure Lakeside maintains safety as our first priority during our student entrance and dismissal each day!

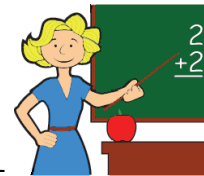

Guest Teacher Opportunities!



Warren Township schools are looking for classroom guest teachers for the 2016-17 school year. Classroom guest teachers, also referred to as substitute teachers, work a 7 1/2 hour day with a 30 minute lunch. Classroom guest teachers are paid \$72 a day and are eligible for a \$100 bonus after completing twenty classroom assignments. With 18 schools, and over 600 classrooms in the district, there are ample opportunities for being assigned to a classroom on a daily basis.
