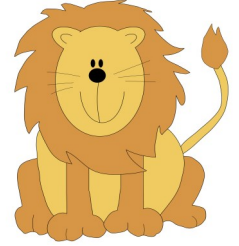

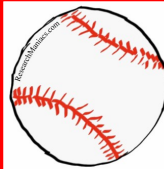


ATTENTION TO PARENTS OF FUTURE ACTORS AND ACTRESSES!!
