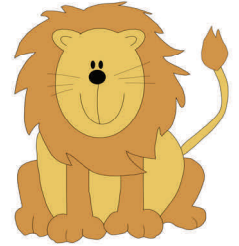

NWEA Testing:

During the week of May 8 your child will take the 3rd round of NWEA tests called Measures of Academic Progress® (MAP®). We give students NWEA MAP tests to determine your child's instructional level and to measure academic growth throughout the school year, and from year to year in the areas of Language Arts, Reading, and Math. Your child will take the tests on a computer.

MAP tests are unique in that they adapt to be appropriate for your child's level of learning. As a result, each student has the same opportunity to succeed and maintain a positive attitude toward testing. Furthermore, with NWEA MAP tests, we can administer shorter tests and use less class time while still receiving detailed, accurate information about your child's growth. Over the course of each school year, students in grades kindergarten through fourth grades take the tests a total of three times. Individual student reports will be shared with you before the end of the school year. If you have any questions, please contact your child's teacher or Mr. Hoog.
