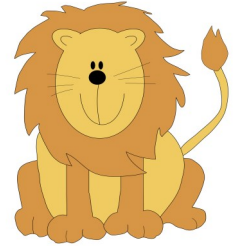

## Mr. Hoog's Headlines...

Dear Lakeside Parents and Guardians,

Next year, all 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade students will continue to be participating in a departmentalized teaching and learning model. Within this model, each student will still officially be assigned a home room teacher. However, their home room teacher will also be paired with another classroom teacher in the same grade level. Their home room teacher will either be a STEM (Math and Science) or ELA (Reading/Writing/Social Studies) teacher. The other teacher in the grade level they will see each day will teach the opposite content areas. Each block (STEM and ELA) will be 2-hours long. In addition, our 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade Excel classrooms will also work together. Mr. Gardner will teach the STEM block and Miss Nelms will teach the ELA block to both 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms. Your primary contact teacher will be your child's home room teacher, but you will be encouraged to keep in contact with both teachers regarding your child's progress throughout the upcoming year.

All parents will have the opportunity to meet teachers before school begins, on the evening of Thursday, July 27. Specific details regarding the Meet the Teacher Night will be given at registration day on Tuesday, July 18, from 12:00-8:00 p.m. As always, please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.

I want to give a special THANK YOU to all of our 4<sup>th</sup> grade students and families. It's hard to believe the children are moving on to the intermediate level! It's been a pleasure to see so many of our children with us for the past 5 years! We will miss each and every one of you and wish you all the best!

If you and your child are leaving Lakeside, I would like to thank you for all you have done to make Lakeside a better place and I wish you the best in your transition to your next school. If you are returning to Lakeside, we look forward to seeing you at Back to School registration on Tuesday, July 18, 2017, from 12:00-8:00 p.m. Please know that it is very important that you attend registration in order for us to obtain updated information and to ensure we have your child placed in a classroom for the first day of school.
