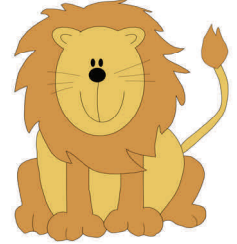

Guest Teacher Opportunities!



Warren Township schools are looking for classroom guest teachers for the 2016-17 school year. Classroom guest teachers, also referred to as substitute teachers, work a 7 1/2 hour day with a 30 minute lunch. Classroom guest teachers are paid \$72 a day and are eligible for a \$100 bonus after completing twenty classroom assignments. With 18 schools, and over 600 classrooms in the district, there are ample opportunities for being assigned to a classroom on a daily basis. Student Drop-off/Pick-up Procedures

We ask that our parents follow these guidelines to insure that every student has a safe arrival and dismissal:

In order to increase the safety of all of our students and adults entering and leaving the building each day, all students will be required to be dropped-off and picked-up through the car rider line. Parking at the front and East end of the building and walking children to and from the entrances will not be allowed. We would like to prevent children and adults walking through the path of cars or buses on the property at any time.

Staff members will be present outside beginning at 8:30 a.m. each morning for student drop-off. Please do not release your children until a staff member signals the beginning of our process. Students will not be counted tardy until 8:40 a.m. Our afternoon pick-up procedures will begin at 3:30 p.m. If you are in a hurry, you are encouraged to be at or near the front of the line and we will implement our dismissal procedures as quickly and safely as possible for all.

Thank you very much for your support with helping ensure Lakeside maintains safety as our first priority during our student entrance and dismissal each day!



Background Checks

For the safety of our children, a background check must be done on anyone who volunteers at schools or chaperones on field trips. Once a person is approved, the background check is valid for two schools years. Please get this form from your child's teacher and return to school office with a copy of your ID
