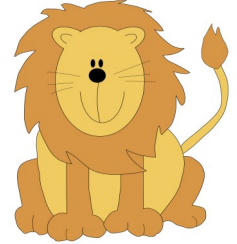

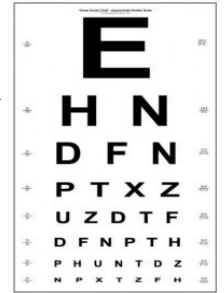
## LOST AND FOUND
